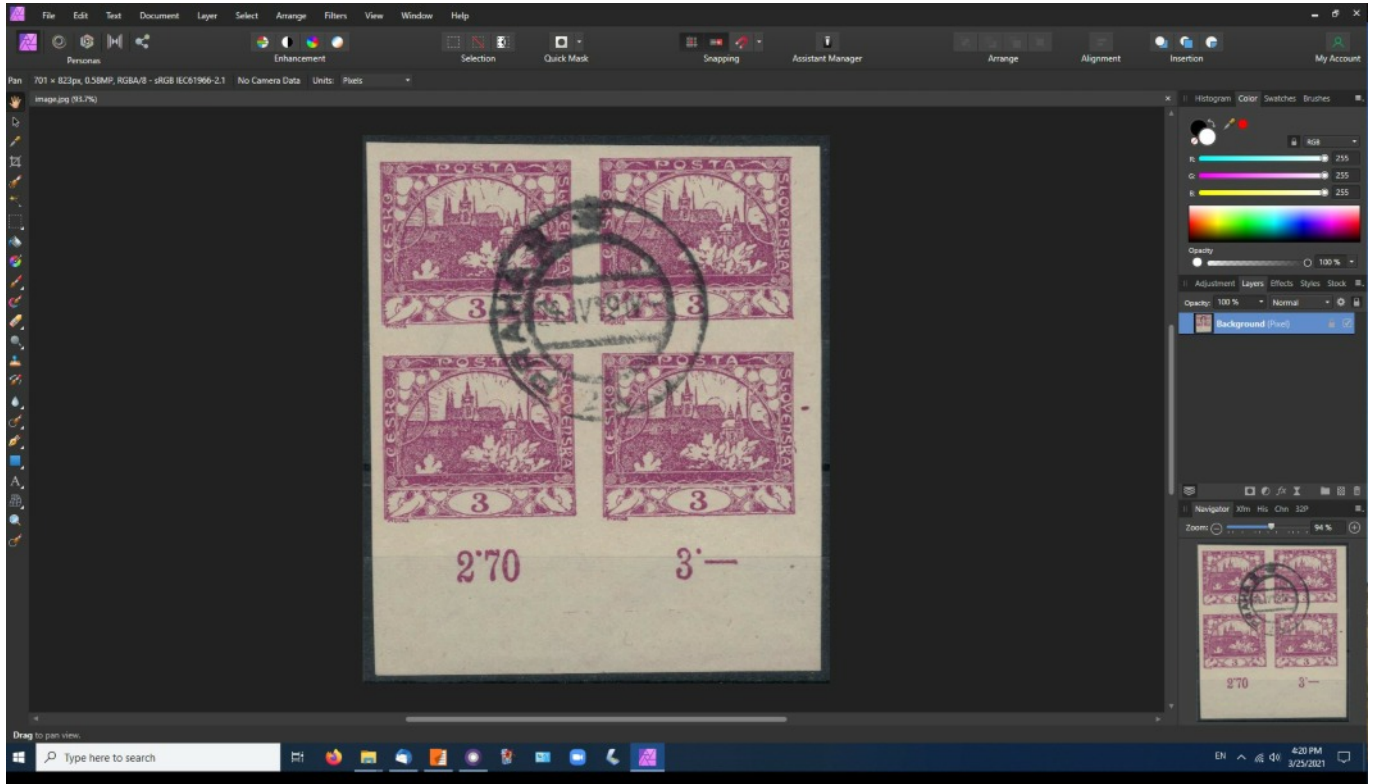


Another Method of Using *Affinity Photo* to Isolate Images of Postmarks

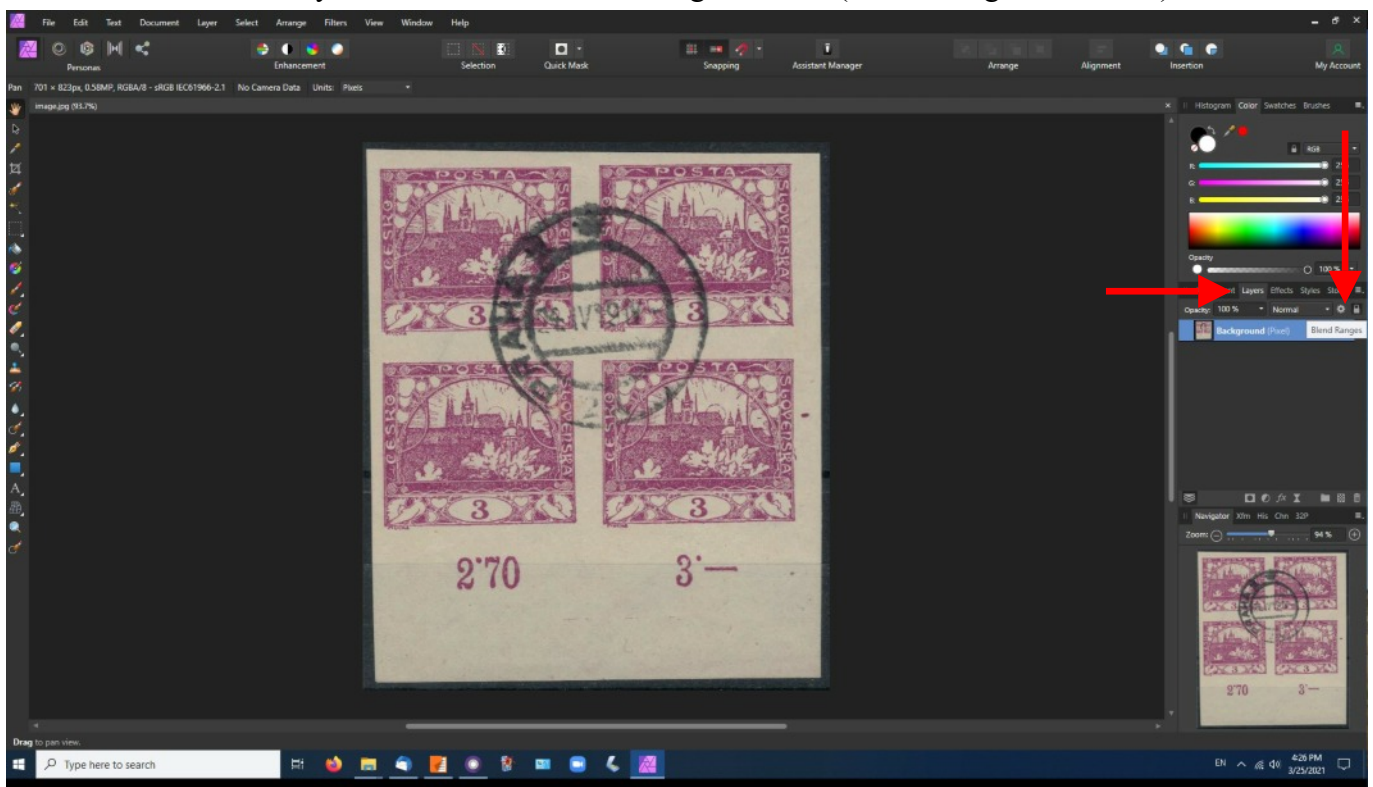

Affinity Photo is an application produced by Serif Ltd, Nottingham, UK.
At the time of this writing it is currently discounted to \$US 25.

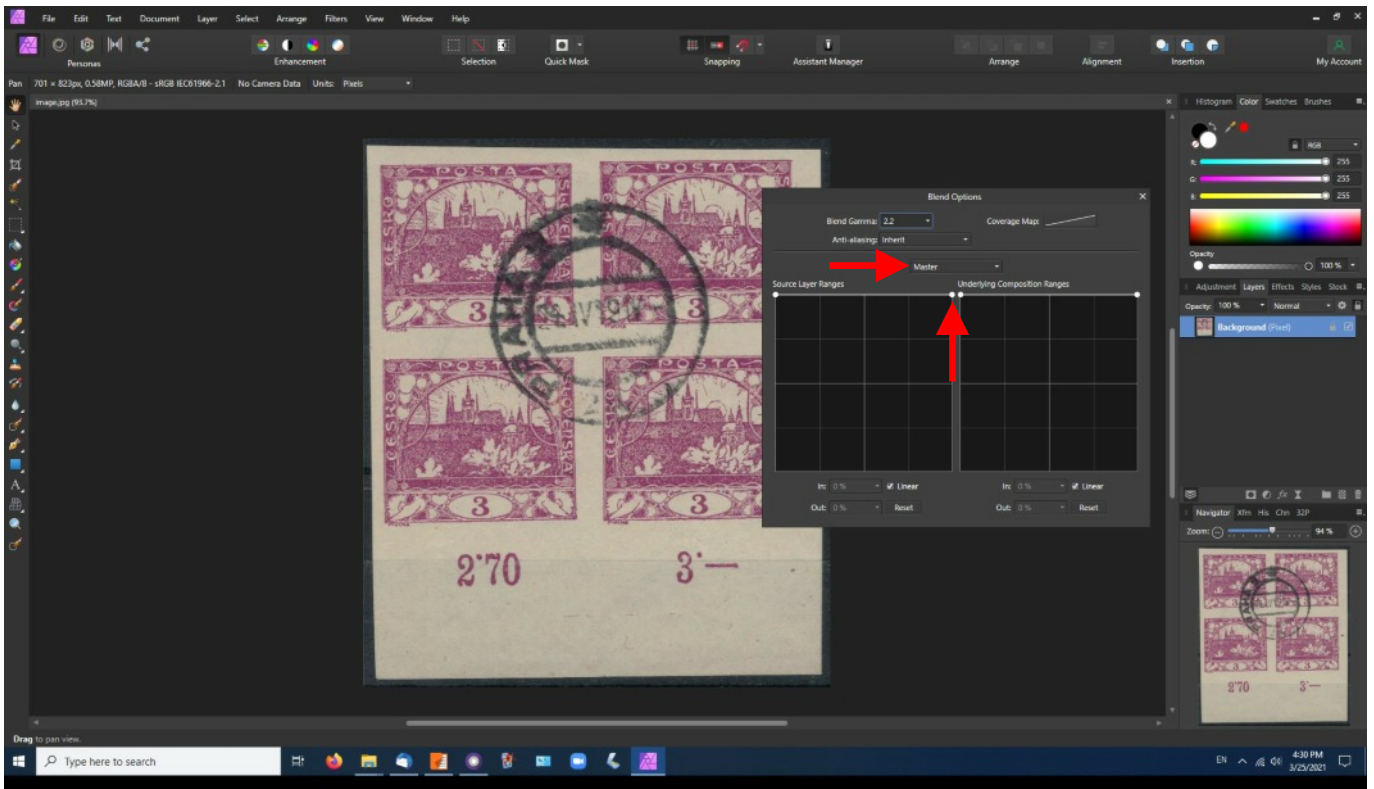
As shown in the earlier procedure, launch *Affinity Photo*, dispose of the opening screen, load the image.



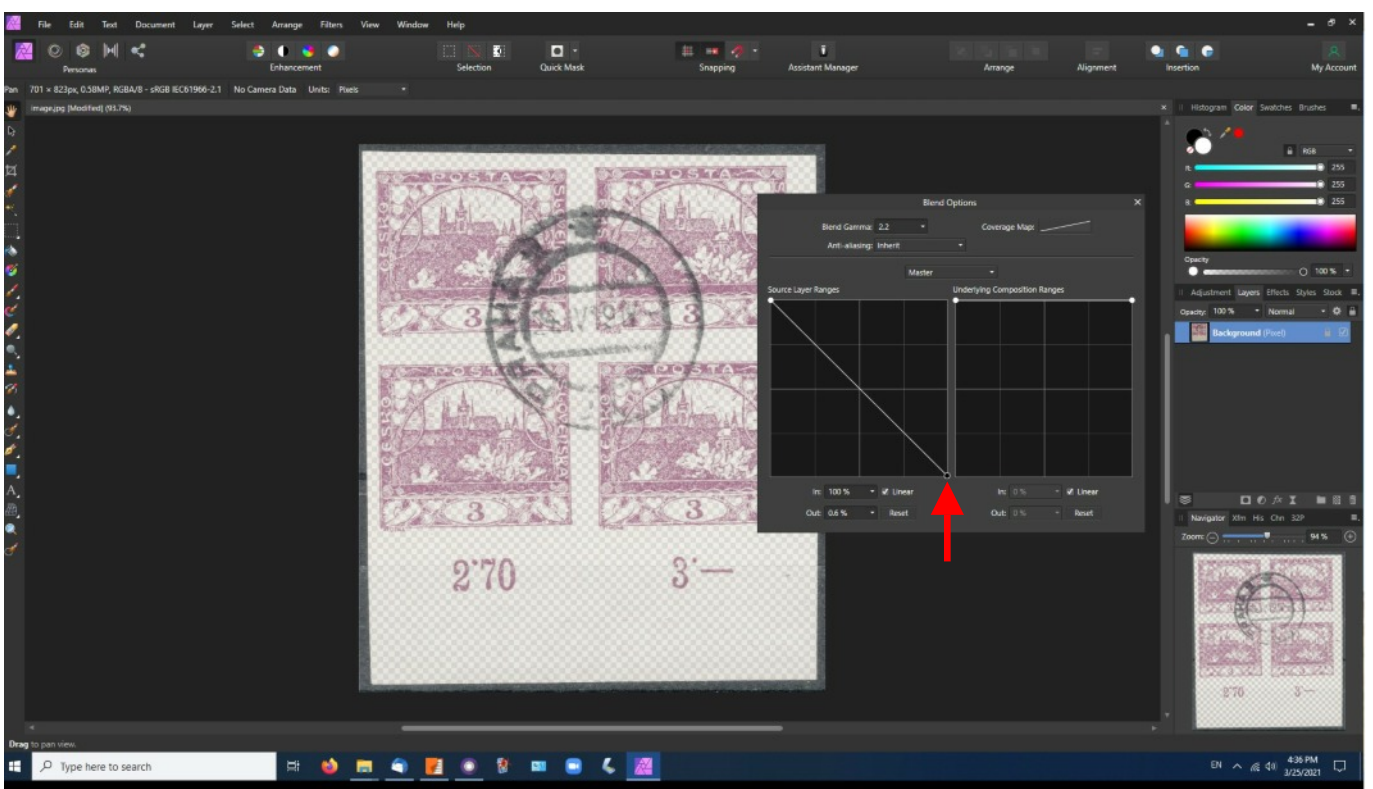
Insure Layers is selected. Click on the gear wheel (Blend Ranges studio tab).



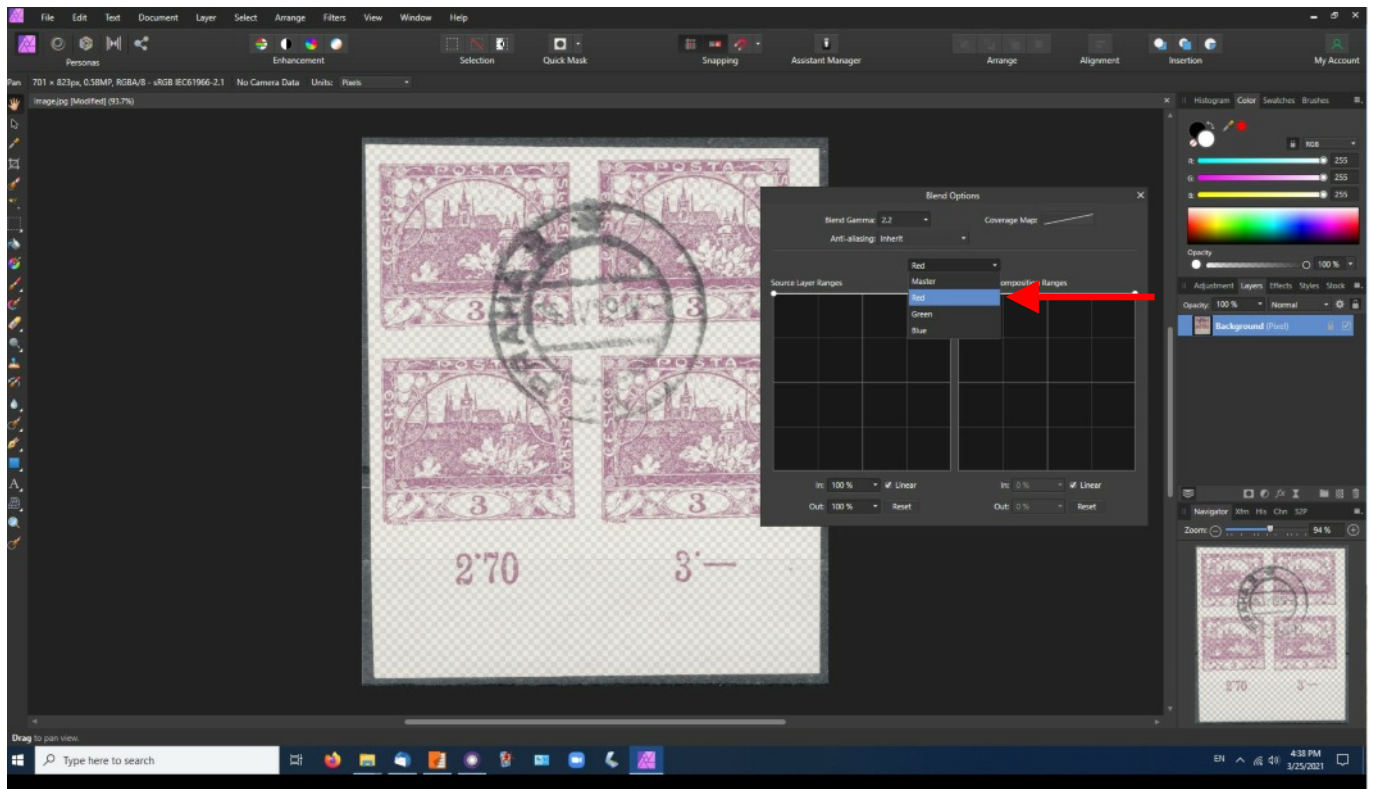
Move the Blend Options dialog out of your way. Make sure Master appears in the drop-down. Click on the right-hand circle on the Source Layer Ranges (it will turn black as you do).



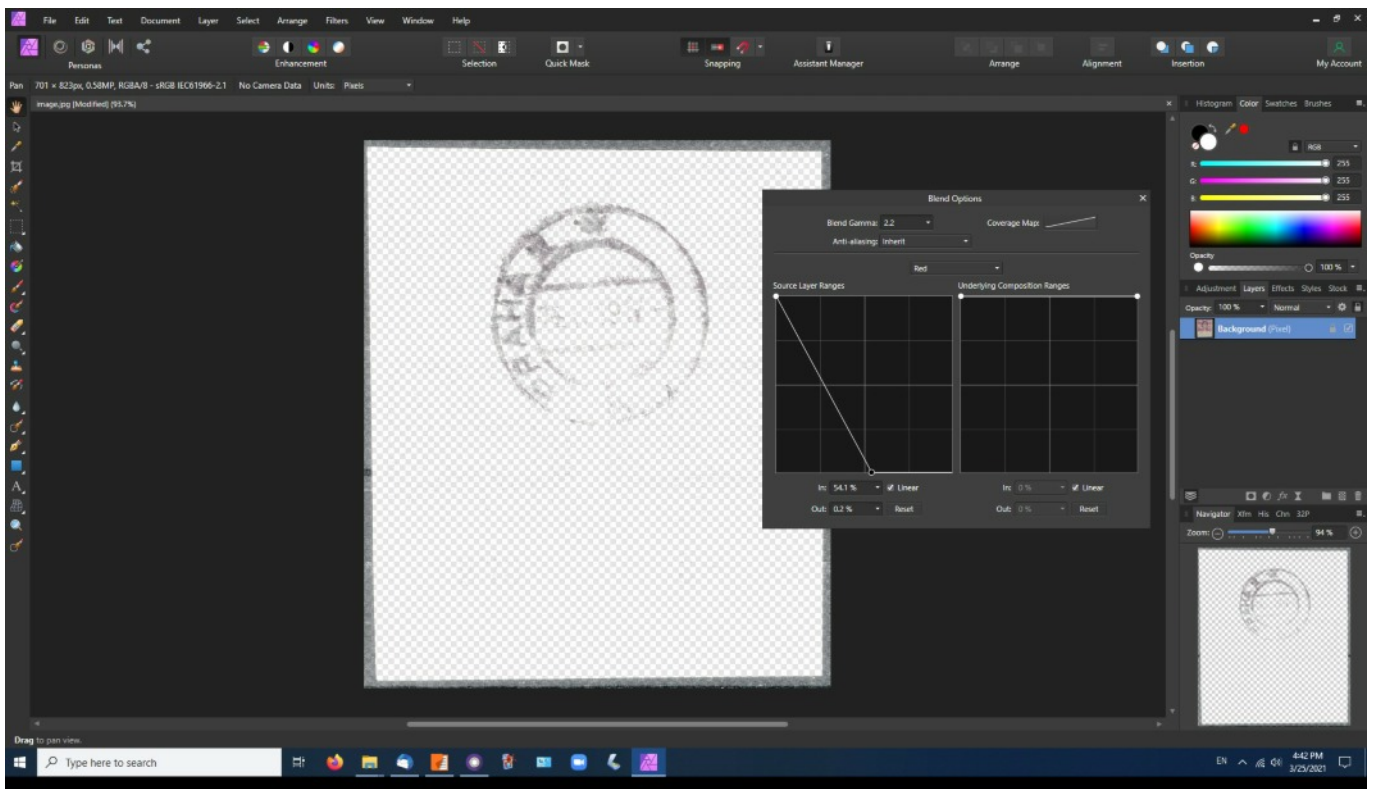
Drag the circle to the lower right hand corner.



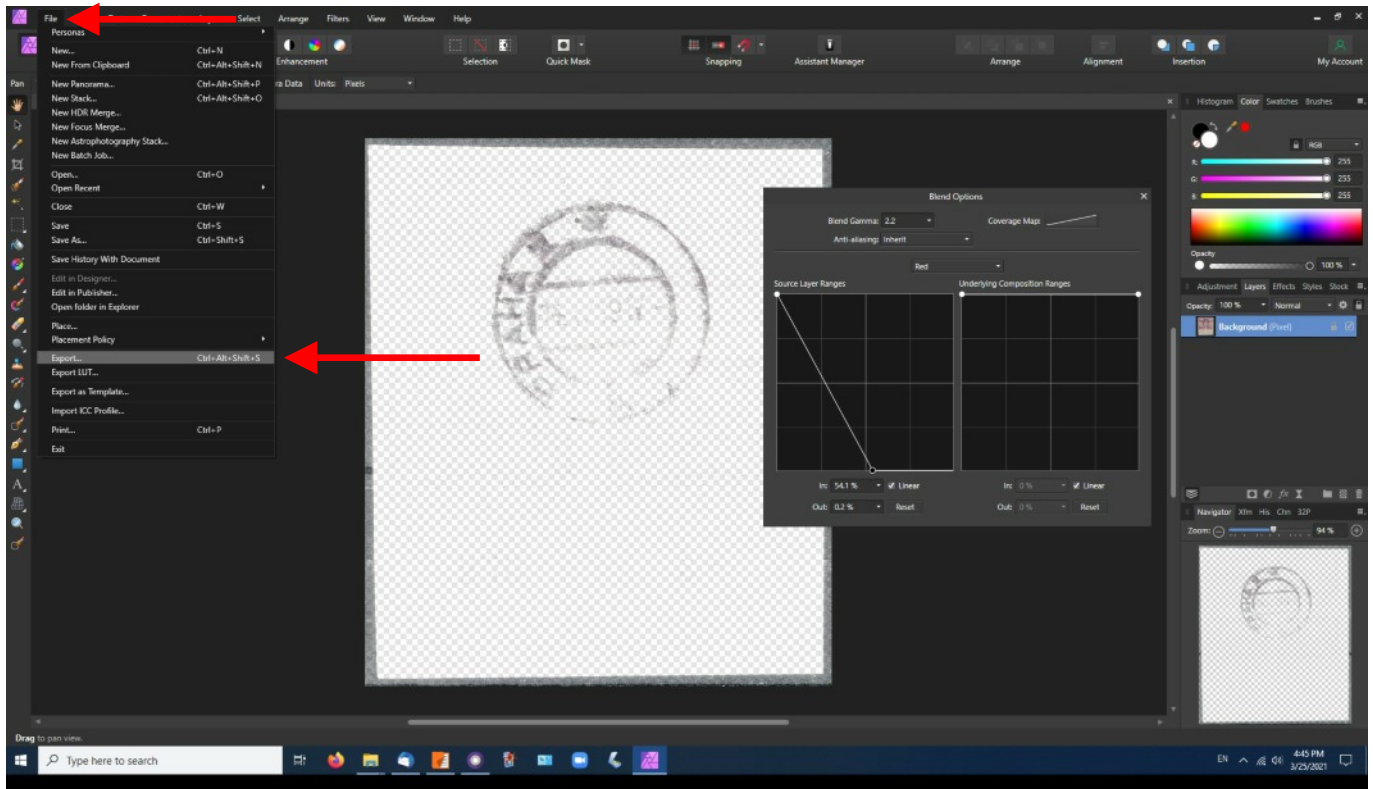
Click on the drop-down box and select the colour of the stamps.



Click on the black circle again, drag it to the bottom of the graph, then leftward until the stamps disappear.



Select File→Export.



Choose a file type and save the file by clicking on Export.
